



Northside Hospital purchases Georgia Baptist Hospital. At the time, the facility had a total of 41 beds.

Began construction of additional medical office building and parking deck on Forsyth's campus followed by the addition of a new surgical center, expansion of robotic surgery and new adult cardiac cath lab.

April 2009: 1,000th baby born at Northside Forsyth.

10th anniversary of Northside Forsyth.

Filed for addition of shared operating rooms and a nine-bed expansion; First procedure performed using the Magellan Robotic System in Georgia (cath lab innovation).

Opened fifth medical office building, bringing expert joint replacement services, sports medicine and physical therapy all under one roof.

October 2021: Construction completed on two-story vertical addition (floors 9 and 10), bringing total inpatient beds to 363.

February 2003: First bed expansion - 37 beds added.

Dedicated Women's Center opens, bringing maternity and newborn services to Forsyth County for the first time in more than 25 years.

The Hospital started another inpatient bed expansion project in 2009, which included some renovation to existing space as well as three new medical/surgical floors and 22 new inpatient beds. Once completed, the hospital had a total of 155 licensed inpatient beds.

August 2013: Completion of fourth medical office building (1800) on campus.

January 2016: First Atlanta-area hospital to offer Leksell Gamma Knife Perfexion with Extend System.

October 2019: Added six new operating rooms (bringing total to 24).

Converted 26 short-stay beds to inpatient, bringing total inpatient beds to 389.

2013-2014: Approved to offer a Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.

Surgical care center opens; Addition of three new floors; Addition of 37 medical-surgical, short stay hospital beds and cafeteria renovation; Plans filed to build out and equip outpatient department in medical office building.

October 2022: 20th anniversary of Northside Forsyth.
